Due to legislation, changes and incidents in other sports the Welfare Co-ordinator has been working on a project over the winter (2017), to completely revamp the way we look at Safeguarding and Welfare for all that are involved in Bury Rounders League. This has led to the new Bury Rounders Safeguarding Initiative (BRSI).
